The family of Jack Agayoff ,who passed away July 4, 2025, has decided to sell two cars from Jack's collection. They want to offer these vehicles to members and friends of the Triangle Chapter first. The two cars are the 1959 Ford Galaxie Retractable Hardtop (Convertible) and a 1954 Mercury Sun Valley Hardtop Coupe (Glass Top).

The 1954 Mercury Sun Valley hardtop coupe is one of 9,761 examples produced for 1954 and features a green-tinted plexiglass roof panel. Power comes from a 256ci V8 paired with a three-speed transmission. Equipment includes power-assisted steering and drum brakes, fender skirts, power windows, a power-adjustable front bench seat, a heater, and an AM radio. The Mercury is one of the last cars Jack acquired and is currently rated as #2 condition. They are asking the Old Cars Price Guide value of \$46,000.



The 1959 the Ford Galaxie Skyliner Retractable Hardtop was offered in the Ford lineup. The Skyliner's retractable top operates via a complex mechanism that folded the front of the roof and retracted it under the rear decklid. 12,915 models were produced in 1959. The Skyliner has an automatic transmission. with power steering and brakes. Jack drove this vehicle to car shows and on weekend cruises. The car is currently rated #3 with a value of \$36,000 per the 2026 Old car Price Guide.
